

News Flash. The long-awaited results of Round 1 Long Reef Club Champs

On Sunday the 17th December 2017 under very decent conditions we had a great turnout with 27 starters for Round 1 of the Long Reef Club Championships. Those who had not yet left for their summer holidays were not disappointed with the warm and inviting 1-2 foot surf. Masters men (40+) had the most competitors with 13, but having 8 Longy gals show up made it the best turn-out ever. The events held were Surf swim, Board Race, Beach Sprint, 1km run, beach flags, Ironman and surf ski. Here follows is the leader boards and rules. There is yet 2 rounds to make up points if you a little behind or not yet started.

Round 2 is February 18th from 10am. Join the fun.

Rules of Long Reef Club Championships

- (1) The objective of Long Reef Club Championships is for maximum member engagement, participation and enjoyment.
- (2) Club Championships will be determined by the cumulation of points over 3 rounds, held on predetermined and advertised dates throughout the Patrolling season. Three dates allowing for at least one date being cancelled due to unfavourable and unsafe conditions i.e Beach Closed.
- (3) Age Categories are
 - Cadet with SRC 13-16 yrs
 - Open 16-39 yrs with Bronze Medallion
 - Masters (40+)
- (4) Gender Categories are
 - male
 - female
- (5) Events are
 - Surf Race. Not compulsory but a bonus point is given for all entrants regardless of placing.
 - Board Race.
 - Beach Sprint
 - Beach Flags
 - Beach Run 1-2km
 - Ironman (board, swim, run)
 - Ski – The winner overall gets 2 points and other entrants a single bonus point.
- (6) Points are to be awarded for each event and totalled over 3 Rounds to determine the winner.
 - 1st Place 5 points
 - 2nd Place 4 points
 - 3rd place 3 points
 - All other entrants in race get 1 point, or 2 points for Surf Race.
 - Masters 60+ get 1 bonus point per event entered regardless of placing
 - Masters 70+ get 2 bonus points per event entered regardless of placing
- (7) Each event must have at least two (2) entrants to be a valid event. However, an individual competing in an event alone will be given a bonus point for participating with other age/gender categories, or 2 points for winning overall.
- (8) Overall Club Champion will be determined by total points regardless of Age/Gender.
- (9) Points are determined by number of entrants per age/gender category. The winner getting points calculated by number of entrants plus 1 and 2 points more than 2nd place.

(10) No member is eligible to win the Championship event unless they are a Financial, Proficient Bronze or SRC holder who has carried out their Patrol Duties.

(11) The Race Secretary and/or Competition Captain will judge all events and deal with any protests.
